

Welcome back to Year 1

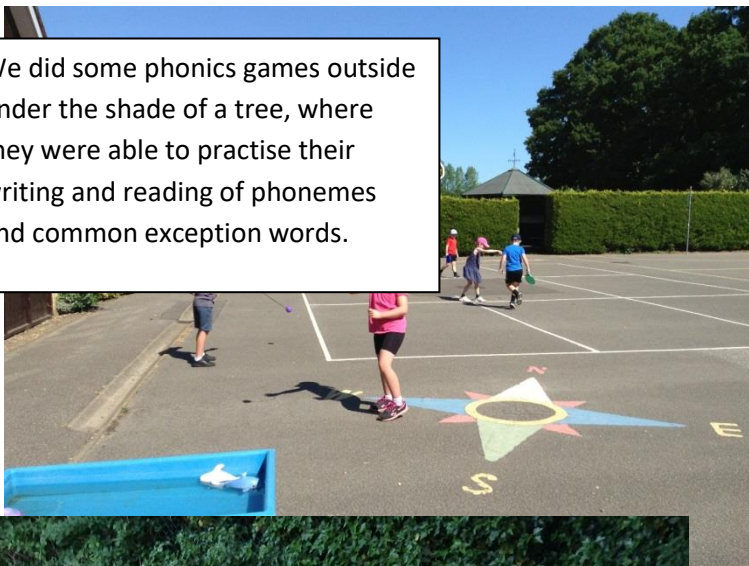
