

# Maths Websites

I have researched and found more websites for maths which have shared some of their resources free of charge during school closures. I think you will have to subscribe, but suggestion is that the resources are free.

I have trawled through all 45 pages of this website and found some activities that may be useful. They are only allowing access to some of the resources so you need to look for those that do not display the *premium* banner.

A word of warning, the search engine is **very** particular! If you miss out the apostrophes it will not find it!

If you type the following into the search bar, the activities **should** come up.

Don't forget your maths pack (Y2-3) (Y3-4) (y4-5) (Y5 -6)

Place Value concertina (Y1 – 6)

Maths at home: 15 ways for parents to help at home (Y1 – Y6)

12 maths club activities for primary schools (a lot these can be adapted to home settings)

12 awesome autumn maths activities (they are autumn but they can be adapted easily)

Holiday maths packs brain drain buster(Y5 & Y6)

Topical maths problems (Y5 & Y6)

Once you have logged on, click on the *National Curriculum Resource Tool*. You are then given a variety of maths topics and year groups. Click on what you would like to revise or learn, click *show selection* at the bottom and you will be given a variety of resources. There are tab headings for activities, exemplification and videos to support the learning. The availability varies depending on topic, but there are some excellent activities and you may find the exemplification useful.

Do try out the ttrackstars and numbots if you get chance, as they really are fun and engaging for the children.
