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Dear Parents/Carers

The full schedule of remote learning will start next week, following the timetables already sent out. All teachers will be setting work via assignments on Teams as this makes it much easier for work to be handed in.

As well as completing the remote learning tasks set, we ask that all children continue to read regularly and practise their times tables. If you are struggling for books to read at the appropriate level, please contact the office and we can arrange for some to be left at the front entrance.

If your child is in Y1-Y6 and a critical worker/vulnerable child, please ensure that they bring their Power Maths workbooks to school on the days they attend. They will then be able to complete their work in school and take the workbooks home again for when they are needed.

Please do try follow the timetable set by the class teachers, where possible, especially if your child is attending school on some days, to avoid repetition.

Just a reminder that assemblies will take place on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 2.45-3pm, starting next Monday 11th, technology allowing! Please click on the link sent via Teams to access the assembly. Class assemblies will take place on Wednesdays; class teachers will send out a link. Celebration assembly will take place each Friday so please encourage the children to work hard as they may be awarded with a certificate!

Mr Lawrence is also going to be sharing weekly music videos which can be accessed through YouTube. Class teachers will send out the links with their remote learning.

Well done to you all, children and parents, for surviving the first week of home schooling. I know it's not been easy but you are all doing a fantastic job! I would also like to thank the staff for the way they have responded to the transition to remote learning at such short notice. We are all learning together as we go along and I'm sure that very soon we will all be experts in using Teams.
